A 30% partnership agreement rate for Maryland Counseling Association members!

Argosy University, Northern, VA is offering a 30% partnership agreement rate to Maryland Counseling Association (MCA) members who apply to Argosy University, Northern VA's EdD in Counselor Education and Supervision, EdD in Counseling Psychology, and MA in Clinical Mental Health Counseling degree programs by December 15, 2017 and are accepted to start the program on January 4, 2018. This 30% partnership agreement rate will be for the duration of the degree. MCA members who apply after December 15, 2017 can take advantage of a 20% partnership agreement rate. This partnership gives an opportunity for qualified students to obtain a tuition reduction at Argosy University, Northern, VA.

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE? Applicants must meet all of the following eligibility requirements:

1. The applicant must meet the admission requirements for the program of interest.
2. The applicant must be a paid member of MCA.
3. Applicants can only utilize one Argosy University Partnership Agreement rate towards tuition. Combining Argosy University Partnership Agreement rates is not permitted. If the continuing student has been utilizing any other Argosy University Partnership Agreement rates, the continuing student must select only one partnership agreement rate, for which they are eligible, prior to the start of the following semester. Partnership Agreement rates are not retroactive and can only apply to current semesters. Argosy University reserves the right to approve, or revoke, partnership agreement rates for any and all causes.

The partnership agreement rates will be awarded in the form of a tuition credit and are not redeemable for cash.
